Thank you for your recent inquiry about our fantastic dog daycare facility. Muttessori is committed to providing a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for your pet during weekday business hours. At Muttessori, your dog will not be left alone or crated for long hours, but will enjoy supervised playtime with other pets. While attending our facility, your dog will be reminded of appropriate behavior and manners around both humans and canines. Jumping up, excessive barking, and bolting through doors is discouraged, while fun and exercise **are** encouraged!

A few benefits of our program include:

- Helps develop social skills
- Provides necessary exercise
- Curbs destructive behavior due to boredom
- Helps reduce separation anxiety
- Develops physical fitness

To be accepted into Muttessori, all dogs must go through an interviewing process. It is important that all dogs at our facility interact positively with one another. All dogs must be non-aggressive.

Included you will find all the information and forms you need to register you pet for our fantastic services.

To apply, simply complete the forms in this packet and return them to Muttessori School for Dogs at 2702 Peger Rd. Fairbanks, AK 99709. You may register though the mail, or if you prefer, you may drop your application off in person. Once we receive your application packet, we will review the forms and call to schedule a time when we can meet you and your pet!

Muttessori School for Dogs
General Information and Policies

To insure the safety and health of your pet and other guests, we require all guests to comply with the following guidelines:

- AGE: Dogs must be 16 weeks (4 months) of age or older. Contact our office for exceptions.
- SEX: All dogs 24 weeks (6 months) or older must be spayed or neutered.
- VACCINATIONS: All dogs must have current vaccinations:
 - Annual *Leptospirosis*
 - Rabies
 - 3 year DHPPV, after one-year booster as recommended in the AHAA guidelines.
 - Annual Intranasal Bordetella.
 - All dogs will be given pyrantel dewormer orally upon entry, or every 30 days.
 - All dogs will be given a lice treatment orally upon entry, or every 30 days.
- HEALTH: All dogs must be in good general health. Pet parents will certify that their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Upon admission all dogs must be free of any condition that could jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require a veterinarian certification of health to be accepted or re-admitted. Dogs with stitches are not allowed in doggie daycare until they are removed. (This policy is enforced with the protection and well-being of your pet in mind.)
- BEHAVIOR: All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Pet parents will certify that their dogs have not harmed or shown any aggression towards any other person or dog. Your dog will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals in our daycare is our main concern. You are financially responsible for all medial bills incurred while attending Daycare.
- APPLICATION: All dogs must have a complete, up to date and approved application on file. Upon acceptance, there is a once a week minimum, 2-month initial commitment. Any dogs unscheduled for 4 weeks or longer must schedule a re-interview (\$5.00 each) before being allowed to re-attend Muttessori.
- FEES: Payment is due upon pick-up, unless a pre-paid package has been purchased.

* There is a \$2.00 additional fee for administering medications.

- DAYS AND HOURS: Monday through Friday, 7am to 6pm. Arrivals between 7am and 8am are to be put in their nap crates until Pet Care attendant arrives at 8am. (7am to 8am IS NOT included in calculating ½ day visits!) Daily scheduled “Naptime is from 2:00pm to 3:00pm to allow dogs to “re-charge their batteries” and to break staff for lunch. Muttessori is not an overnight facility. Staff goes off duty at 6pm and there is a \$1.00 late fee per minute for any pet left after 6pm. Dogs on board past 6:30 will automatically be charged an overnight fee in accordance with our separate boarding facility. Muttessori is closed on all holidays.
- RESERAVTIONS: Reservations guarantee availability for your pets. Muttessori accepts walk-ins as space permits and on a first come, first serve basis. Clients will be charged in full for no-shows and for cancellations with less than 24-hour notice.
- PLAYTIME: We will provide all play equipment and toys. Toys from home will not be accepted into our program. Blankets and/or beds from home are welcome for your pet’s comfort during rest periods and naptime.
- **SPECIAL NOTE:** All dogs MUST have a properly fitted collar and leash while entering and exiting our facility. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- In the event the PET becomes ill while in care, MUTTESSORI will contact the OWNER’S veterinarian of record. If unable to reach the OWNER’S veterinarian of record, or if the situation demands urgent attention MUTTESSORI is specifically authorized to obtain such prompt attention, as the PET requires. ALL costs incurred by MUTTESSORI concerning such treatment, if any, shall be the obligation of the OWNER and shall be promptly paid to MUTTESSORI as reimbursement, which may be at the time of pick-up of the PET. The OWNER shall hold MUTTESSORI, its officer agents, and employees harmless from any and all actions, injuries, or damages as the result of such veterinary treatment.
- MUTTESSORI shall not be responsible, nor held liable, for any injury, illness, and/or death to PET placed in its care from disease or natural disaster, including, but not limited to: tornadoes, storms, civil riots, or any other acts beyond MUTTESSORI control. However, if loss of PET occurs while in the care of MUTTESSORI from any other cause, except “old age,” MUTTESSORI will either (A) replace the PET with a similar PET; or (B) provide cash payment to OWNER in an amount equal to the value of such PET at the time of such loss; or (C) Three Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$300.00); whichever is less. The OWNER agrees not to hold MUTTESSORI liable for any direct or indirect, consequential or inconsequential damages to the OWNER of the PET resulting from either PET’S illness or death.
- OWNER represents that he/she has legal ownership of their PET and accepts total responsibility for all actions taken by MUTTESSORI, and all charges that may arise out of this agreement.
- OWNER shall reimburse MUTTESSORI for all cost and/or legal fees incurred by MUTTESSORI resulting from breach of this Agreement.
- OWNER agrees, by signing this Agreement, at the time of initial visit, that OWNER shall be bound by the terms of this Agreement, now and at any time in the future when OWNER leaves his/her PET at MUTTESSORI
